Amico	TK - K 97 students	\$537.00	Drying Racks We create a lot of art projects in TK/K and some classrooms do not have drying racks any more (not sure where they went over the summer) and the ones that are still here are original to the school and not sturdy. The artwork often falls through the slots and the wheels don't work well to move it around the room. These new drying racks will appear more modern in our classrooms for parent tours and will work better in our classrooms for art projects that are too big to lay out on tables to dry.
